- Involve you as appropriate in the further development of our programmes; and,
- Seek to improve your career development opportunities by looking at ways in which our links with other organisations can generate opportunities for work experience and volunteering.

Your College will provide:

- A high quality learning experience, with qualified, skilled and professional staff who are passionate about their disciplines and their desire to make your learning challenging but, at the same time, exciting;
- Appropriate access to the resources that you need to complete your studies;



- ✓ Where appropriate, opportunities to allow you to study in a way that suits your needs;
- Constructive and timely feedback on your work so that you can further develop your academic and life skills;
- Opportunities for you to contribute to quality enhancement across the College; and,
- A range of services and facilities that are aimed at enhancing your student experience with us.

As a student at the College <u>you</u> will:

Recognise that <u>you</u> are part of a creative and dynamic learning community and at all times respect those around you by:

- Treating others that you come into contact with, either in person or virtually, with tolerance, dignity and respect;
- ✓ Using and adhering to all College policies; and,
- Respecting your environment, either on or off campus.

Play an active role as a partner in <u>your</u> learning by:
